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Torei's Story.....

Hello there! My name is Torei and I want to tell you my story. At 36 weeks my mommy had found fluid in my brain then had a fetal MRI that showed I suffer from Agenesis of the Corpus Callosum (ACC). I was then flagged for high risk of seizures. From birth to the day I turn 2 months old I was seizure free. November 24th, I started my journey of seizures that lead to brain surgery. I've been admitted into Phoenix Children's Hospital (PCH) three times (Nov. 24th to Nov. 26th), (Nov. 29th to Dec. 5th) and (Dec. 17th to Jan. 12th). I was flown to PCH on Nov. 29th because my seizures were so strong I lost a whole pound in 2 days and stopped eating. On Dec. 17th I was admitted after coding at my neurology follow-up but I started breathing before my heart stopped. On Jan. 6th I had a hemispherectomy done because I was having over 100 seizures a day and only increasing. I now have less than 10 seizures a day and I'm starting to babble, watch my family and grab my rattles again. My journey is nowhere done and has only begun.
